
Focus on... Adoremus Eucharistic Congress

This important national event takes place in Liverpool next weekend. It aims to help us all to appreciate more deeply the amazing gift of the Eucharist: Jesus, who makes Himself present in the form of bread and wine. In the parish we will mark the congress in several ways:

Friday: the First Friday Holy Hour, 7-8pm

Saturday: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 10:30am until 6pm. Please sign up to come and pray, if you can commit to a particular slot. Or just drop in and pray before the Lord. At the same time, several parishioners will be at the congress in Liverpool, taking part in the workshops and hearing others speak about the Eucharist.

Sunday: The parish is taking two coaches to Liverpool for the **Blessed Sacrament Procession** which will take place on the streets of the city in the afternoon. There are still some places – sign up in the narthex this weekend if you would like to come. Then, back at St Clare's at 7pm, the **CTS Book Club** will be discussing a





booklet called 'Meeting Christ in the Eucharist'. Feel free to drop in, listen or contribute your own thoughts.
