


FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER 19th May 2019

Franciscan of the Week: St Bernardino of Siena

Bernadino (1380-1444) was a dynamic missionary. He is sometimes referred to as 'the Apostle of Italy' and was compared to St Paul by the Pope, on account of his missionary zeal and success. He spent a year running a hospital for plague victims, after which he was ill for several months. At 22 he became a Franciscan friar, and spent almost twelve years in solitude and prayer before





devised the symbol 'IHS', which is sometimes seen in churches. Taken from the first three letters of the word Jesus in Greek, it represents the Holy Name, to which Bernardino had a great devotion. This outstanding friar was canonised in 1450.

Focus on... Devotion to Our Lady

May is a month of special devotion to Our Lady. We honour her because God chose her to be the mother of His Son, and because He kept her free from all sin from the moment of her conception. We also show our gratitude to her, because without her faith and generosity, we could not have received Jesus as our Saviour. There are many ways to show our love for Mary: we could



say a decade of the Rosary, light a candle by her statue, say one of the many great prayers to her (e.g. Hail Mary, Hail Holy Queen, Memorare). It's an important part of our devotional lives to ask Mary's intercession, trusting that she watches over us as a mother, and always leads us to her Son. Let's make sure we do something this month to honour Our Lady, and thank her for the love and care she shows us.
