Today's feast celebrates the brief unveiling of the glory of Jesus to three of His disciples: Peter, James and John. These same three Apostles would see Jesus suffering in the garden of Gethsemane, but first they were given a glimpse of the glory that is really His. We hear an account of this event in the Gospel, and in the second reading St Peter writes about his experience of seeing Jesus' glory on Mount Tabor. We too, through prayer, can glimpse something of the glory of Christ.





Focus on... Feast of St Clare

This Friday we celebrate our patronal feast. St Clare is an inspiring patron saint for our parish: a woman completely devoted to Christ, giving up her riches to live a life of poverty in a community she founded.

Clare spent most of her life in the convent, devoting herself to prayer. She didn't travel the world, yet during her lifetime around 150 convents and monasteries were founded as a result of her example and prayers. Our prayer

On Friday we will celebrate her feast day with Mass at 12noon, and at 7pm the 'Transitus of St Clare' – a service of prayer from the Franciscan tradition, celebrating Clare's entry into heaven.
